NATIONAL GEOSPATIAL INFORMATION

The Chief Directorate: National Geospatial Information (CD: NGI) of the Branch: National Geomatics Management Services (NGMS) within the National Department of Land Reform and Rural Development (DLRRD) is South Africa’s national mapping organisation, responsible for establishing and maintaining the national geodetic and control survey system, providing national aerial imagery and mapping coverage, and offering professional and advisory services.

SECTIONS TO BE VISITED:

- Control Survey (TrigNet) – TrigNet is a network of continuously operating GNSS base stations covering South Africa all managed and controlled by a single control centre situated in the offices of National Geospatial Information (NGI). The first stations in the network were installed in 1999 and by September 2010 consisted of more than 55 operational stations, further stations are planned to expand the network.
- The Survey Museum
- Photogrammetric department (AT DEM and orthorectification)
- Map production – This includes the popular 1:10 000 orthophoto and 1:50 000 topographic, numerous other smaller scale, provincial and national maps. Orthorectified imagery, elevation data (including DEMS), vector topographic data as well as raster maps are available digitally.
